- MRCC alarmed HCS112
- Oscar Wild was docked at quay 103



► Once the vessel is in the harbour

- Handover MIRG-team  local Fire Brigade
- Triage victims
- Emergency plan mass rescue: to organise and coordinate the sheltering of a large scale of persons on board and/off victims at a safe place



- Registration of all sheltered passengers & crew

► CP-OPS :Seastation: Leopold II-dam

- Operational coördination
- Every disciplines is represented

► What are the main tasks ?

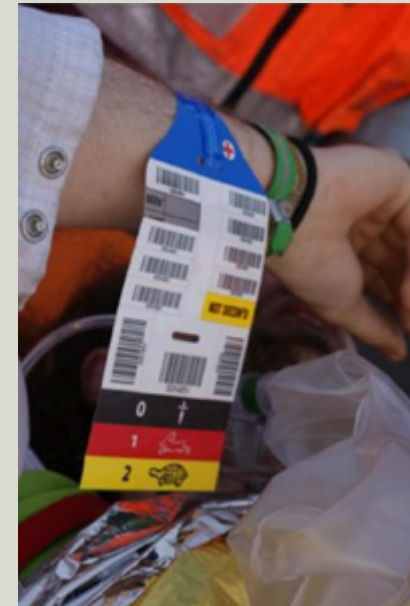
- 1. Exploration by Fire Brigade**
- 2. Triage on board of the ship**
- 3. Evacuation of victims**
- 4. VMP (medical post at the scene)**
- 5. Handover from MIRG to the Fire Brigade**
- 6. Registration of victims and sheltering in Marine Base**
- 7. Family reception Area**

► Evacuation of victims



► VMP: Zone of first medical care

- Identification of victims
- Triage: green, yellow, red, black
- Stabilisation
- Prepare for transport
- Evacuation to hospital(s)



► Triage



► Registration of victims

- **First registration on the ship by captain**
 - passenger list
 - crew list
- **Second: full registration in reception place**
- **Thirdly: victims are registered by D2**
 - CIP : **C**entral **I**nformation **P**oint

► Registration



► Sheltering in Marine Base

- **Reception place**
- **First needs: food, blankets**
- **Information about assistance**
- **Psychosocial team present**
