- Emergency plan mass rescue: to organise and coordinate the sheltering of a large scale of persons on board and/off victims at a safe place

- Every disciplines is represented




Operational coordination : CP-OPS



► What are the main tasks ?

- **1. Exploration by Fire Brigade**
- 2. Triage on board of the ship
- 3. Evacuation of victims
- 4. VMP (medical post at the scene)
- 5. Handover from MIRG to the Fire Brigade
- 6. Registration of victims and sheltering in Marine Base
- 7. Family reception Area





► VMP: Zone of first medical care

- Identification of victims
- Triage: green, yelow, red, black
- Stabilisation
- Prepare for transport
- Evacuation to hospital(s)









Registration of victims

- First registration on the ship by captain
 - \rightarrow passenger list
 - \rightarrow crew list
- Second: full registration in reception place
- Thirdly: victims are registrated by D2

→ CIP : Central Information Point





Sheltering in Marine Base

- Reception place
- First needs: food, blankets
- Information about assistance
- Psychosocial team present
